

EID Numbers in your Blanket

EID (electronic identification number) is the unique number assigned to each sheep at birth. It allows us to identify and keep track of records tied to that individual like fleece weight, number of lambs born and mature weight.

The EID tag was scanned when each sheep was shorn earlier this year. We then printed a barcode and kept it with each fleece. Once the fleece was sorted, it was placed in the bale and the barcode was scanned, that's how we're able to know what sheep's fleece is in each bale. Once the fleece is put in the bale, we lose track of the individual fleeces, which is why you can only see a long list of possible fleeces. We hope you think this is as cool as we do!
